

Security Planning

- ICANN's Meetings Team has met with Regional and Central Government Officials, including Telangana and Cyberabad Police Commissioners, who have committed their full support to security.

Venue Security Support

- Vehicle searches
- Walkthrough metal detectors, magnetic wands
- Bag Scanners

(Note: These are all standard security measures in Hyderabad. All guests and visitors must go through the screening at the HICC and the attached Novotel Hotel.)

Health & Safety Center (HSC)

- ICANN will again have a **Health & Safety Center** operating at the venue.
- An emergency number will be printed on badges and the hotline will be available 24 hours a day for any type of health and safety emergency.
- Local police officers will also be working at ICANN's HSC during the week to support ICANN's security team.
- We will again have a medical team available at ICANN's HSC during all meeting dates, part of our new standard setup.
